- Must finance your project via an institutional bank account

- Reduces the disease burden on patients and/or their families and/or,
- Improves patient care by optimizing prevention, networking, care, education, communication, outcome, and quality of life

An independent jury evaluates all projects and announces the grant winner at the Swiss Cancer Institute's semi-annual meeting on June 18, 2026 where he/she will be requested to present a short exposé on the planned project.
